



# **RREUSE International social enterprise network**




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


#### 1 million tonnes of material diverted from landfill through re-use, repair and recycling included:

# **\*** 7-10 textile containers = 1 job




Global textile production doubled from 50 billion units to 100 billion units between 2000 and 2015

Change behaviour and reduce consumption

Set mandatory rules on durability and ease of repair

Ban destruction of overstock

Understand consequences of 2025 separate collection obligation on textile value-chain

Set targets and incentives prioritising re-use over recycling

Design EPR to ensure financial and operational support re-use and preparation for re-use activities Ensure social enterprises are well represented within EU strategies on textiles and encourage social / public / private partnerships

Direct public and private financing towards business models and investments supporting product life extension

Use social clauses and considerations in public and private tenders


