Background

For the European economy to become truly circular, all stakeholders need to get involved: public authorities, businesses, trade unions, civil society and many more. This is why this stakeholder platform was born and here is how.

To accelerate the transition towards a circular economy, the Commission included in its 2015 EU Action Plan for the Circular Economy two actions to engage with stakeholders through existing fora and to support the exchanges of good practices. To speed up the process of making a resource-efficient economy a reality, the EESC called for the creation of a European circular economy platform. By no means a lone voice, the Council of the European Union, the European Parliament and the European Committee of the Regions also underlined the importance of involving actors from various sectors for an inclusive transition.

An interinstitutional endeavour, in close cooperation with European civil society.









The European Circular Economy Stakeholder Platform brings together stakeholders active in the broad field of the circular economy in Europe. As a "network of networks" it goes beyond sectorial activities and highlights cross-sector opportunities and challenges, providing a meeting place for stakeholders to share their solutions and team up to address specific challenges. It is a stakeholder hub for knowledge and dialogue and serves to bridge existing initiatives, advocating the circular economy at national, regional and local level, and supporting its implementation.
